BADGE OF TRUTH trailed for half, circled rivals when making bid leaving far turn, swung six wide into lane, responded to strong handling racing mid track, surged clear in final strides. OBJECTIVE allowed to settle while racing along inside, came three wide into lane, responded well and just missed in a game effort. SLEW BY SLEW stalked pace throughout, moved up to loom danger mid stretch, weakened late. YES HE'S BEST dueled along inside from start, held slight advantage mid stretch, tired. GARBU'S SON raced four wide from back into lane, failed to menace in drive. MANOVAN dueled from start, responded to gain nod at the half, gave way into lane. SIR STEPHEN stalked leaders while along rail to stretch, faded. GUAPETON never threatened.
