TRICKY MON allowed to settle early, moved up along rail into stretch, came off rail, responded to handling, got up in time. LAIDBACKLYNNY was never far back, moved up along rail to loom danger mid stretch, went gamely to wire but unable to match strides with winner late. ZAVATA FLASH broke to front, set pace to mid stretch, went gamely under pressure before tiring. BRONZE FOX was never far back, five wide into stretch, lacked late response. EAGLE TWO HUNDRED chased pace for half, gave way. EURO SILVER JET failed to menace. FOR GLORY chased pace for half, faded. FIVE ALARM was never threat.
