PURSUE A DREAM dueled along rail from outset, responded to gain advantage at the half, responded to steady handling into stretch, sustained effort during stretch drive, prevailed. HEZA WILD GUY hustled to front, dueled on the outside of rival at the half, went gamely to wire but unable to match strides with winner during stretch drive. QUITE A HANDFUL was never far back, came three wide into stretch, went gamely during stretch drive but unable to reach top pair. PEACH BREW was allowed to settle in stride early, commenced bid racing five wide into stretch, finished with a solid belatedly mid track rally. GOING BALLISTIC allowed to settle in stride early when not far back, raced four wide into stretch, finished with mild stretch rally. TRICKY CAUSEWAY raced along inside, failed to menace. CLAUDIA'S FORUM stalked leaders into stretch, gave way. QUE PASO stalked leaders along inside to stretch, gave way. GREYCLIFF EXCHANGE was not a factor.
