MOJO MANIA was allowed to settle early, circled leaving far turn, came six wide into lane, responded to strong handling while racing mid track, got up in time. DELWOOD was never far back, came four wide into stretch, gained narrow edge mid stretch, went gamely to wire only to be outfinished in the end. PHARME LEGEND chased pace into stretch, went gamely during run to wire before weakening in late going. BADGER BO came three wide from middle of pack three wide into stretch, loomed danger mid stretch, flattened out. MONEY RULES was allowed to settle early, came three wide into lane, finished with a mild rally. FROSTY GENERAL forwardly positioned to stretch, lacked response when asked. WACO HUG failed to menace. ALARMING AFLEET forwardly positioned outside rivals for half, faded. EPIC MATCH stalked leaders for half, dropped back. MIDVAIL hustled to front, set pace for three quarter, stopped. FRIDAY NIGHT BOY was always outrun.
