TIZTIME dropped to rail after break, rated to stretch, moved smartly along rail into lane, responded to handling, took over and drew clear in late going. SILVERBDANCING dueled while racing between foes into stretch, went gamely in drive but unable to match strides with winner late, held onto second spot. FIVE ALARM broke to front, set pace along rail into stretch, went gamely under pressure in drive before weakening in late going. ONE ROOM SCHOOL stalked leaders while outside rivals into stretch, tired in drive. TWO JAYS SECRET well back at the half, passed tiring foes in lane. ALPHA LUCKY dueled while racing between foes into stretch, gave way. DEVIL'S GAME stalked leaders into stretch, had no rally. RED SPIDER was never a factor. TO HEIR IS HUMAN was never a threat. LOVE LIBERTY raced widest into stretch, outrun. WOOD TAK was never close, pulled up into stretch, vanned off.
