**Footnotes**

STEALING COPPER within striking distance along rail from outset, responded to open clear advantage mid stretch, kept to task, remained clear to wire. HASHA stalked leaders along inside, moved up along inside to loom danger mid stretch, flattened out. FIN DOCTORE came from middle of pack five wide into lane, finished with a mild rally to gain show spot. TOP TOP SECRET (ARG) stalked leaders on the outside into stretch, flattened out. SUB RIVER well back at the half, failed to menace. GUCCI BOY hustled to front, set pace into mid stretch, gave way. WASABI was never a factor. DUANES LITLETADPOL was never a serious threat. KING'S APPROVAL showed little. D C GIT N GO rushed up wide of rivals into first turn, dueled for half, faded. MICHELLES MOJO MAN was always outrun. SHYBOY was unprepared for the start, lost rider.
