TIZ READY was never far back, circled four wide into stretch, took command mid stretch, responded to mild urging while increasing margin to wire. CAVITATE within striking distance along inside from outset, was no match when asked in drive, but clearly best of others. CLYDE THE RIDE well back into stretch, came five wide into stretch, finished well with belated rally. TIED ON raced in middle of pack into stretch, failed to menace. CHROME DEPUTY was off slow, trailed for half, improved position in lane. BILL'S HAT TRICK was not a factor. WENCESLAO (MEX) was never a threat. FIRE GAME dueled on the outside of rivals from start, responded to gain nod at the half, went gamely to stretch, faded. TRUE TATOO hustled to front, dueled for half, dropped back. WARRENS HEIGHTS vied for early lead on the outside of foes, stopped after half.
