TRICKYEXPECTATIONS within striking distance along inside from outset, moved up along rail into stretch, responded to gain nod mid stretch, kept to task, prevailed. TENSASTRIKE dueled along rail from start, came off rail three wide into stretch, moved up to loom danger in late going, hung. BRECKENRIDGE was allowed to settle early, moved up when making bid along rail into stretch, loom danger in late going, flattened out. AGOSTO'S TUNE was never far back outside rivals, had no rally. THE BIG WAVE stalked leaders for half, gave way. BLUE MEMO was never a factor. CATABOUT was not a threat. CUSTOM JET hustled to front, set pace for half, faded. HANDSOMELY was always outrun.
