PASSION FEVER vied with early pace on the outside from outset, responded to urging to gain nod mid stretch, kept to steady handling and drew clear late. CARSONCITYPROSPECT sent to front, set pace for half, went gamely when challenged in lane but unable to match strides with winner in late going. BEATA was allowed to settle during running, commenced bid racing five wide into stretch, finished with a solid belated mid track rally. PARKLANE PROFIT was never far on the outside of rivals, came four wide into stretch, lacked rally in drive. OSWEGO forwardly positioned along inside, make no bid. FINE COORDINATOR chased pace for half, gave way. QUADRUPLE DANCER failed to menace. SUPER STAR BABY was not a factor. SUGAR PLUM TOO was always outrun.
