DUSTY'S PLAYER stalked the early pace from the outside, inched closer entering the turn, responded when sat down for the drive and wore down rivals the final furlong. DANCING DUDETE outrun early, advanced inside entering the turn, altered outside for the drive but could not reach the winner. VANITY'S SHOWCASE dueled from the inside for the early lead, remained engaged through the turn, gained a clear margin at the eighth pole but could not last. THE GARDENER pressed the early pace from the outside, advanced entering the turn, responded and finished well. AFLEET WIND could only improve position. MISS LEWIS dueled from the outside and tired. SHE IS A OLMOS chased the early pace and tired. IMPERIAL POMEROY forced the early pace and tired. CHELSEA'S KITTY was never close.
