READY up close early from the inside, crept close entering the turn, dueled through the turn, battled through the drive and inched clear late. GOODNESS GRAYSON well placed from the inside early, dueled through the turn, remained engaged through the drive but could not match strides. IRISH DANCER broke sharp from between foes to gain a clear early margin, dueled through the turn, battled through the drive but could not keep pace. YONDER stalked the early pace from the outside, crept closer entering the turn, responded but was too late. JOHNNY'S SLICE dueled from the outside and tired. ANDRUS was no factor. CAGEY OKIE was never close. HEARTLAND FLYER was no threat. PA HUGHES forced the early pace and tired.
