LOUIE THE LIP dueled from the outside for the early lead, battled through the turn with CROSS HAMMERS, put that one away entering the drive, opened a clear margin at the eighth pole and was clear late while kept to task. TIZ MINE stalked the early pace from the inside, inched closer entering the turn, responded but could not reach the winner. CROSS HAMMERS dueled from the inside for the early lead, remained engaged through the turn, held a forward position for the drive but could not keep pace. BROWN OKIE could only pass tired ones. SILVER DANDY was no factor. RIVERSIDES BEST was never close.
