Footnotes

SOFT BLUSH stalked the early pace from the inside, inched closer entering the second turn, responded entering the drive to duel with SEEMEBYTHESEA and outfinished that one late. SEEMEBYTHESEA dueled from the inside for the early lead, remained engaged up the backstretch, fought through the second turn, battled with the winner through the drive but was outfinished. LILMISSSHORTCAKES pressed the early pace from the outside, remained in a forward position for the drive but could not keep pace. NICKI B. SUPER dueled from the outside early, battled up the backstretch, remained forward for the drive then tired. RAMSAY was no factor. MS. NITRAM was no threat. ARDYTHE MCGEE was never close. WOODLAND FAUNA showed little.
