HEZA WILD GUY broke alertly to gain early advantage along rail, rated well on clear lead into stretch, went unchallenged, ridden out to wire. QUE PASO was never far back along inside, responded in drive to get up for place position. EDITOR'S CAT raced in middle of pack along rail, moved up to be nearest leader mid stretch, weakened. PASS THE BISCUITS forwardly positioned along inside into stretch, had no rally. JOE PEAK chased pace to stretch, swung three wide into lane, tired. SELECTO chased pace into stretch, gave way. FIZZY POP was never a factor. HARD ROCKIN ROBYN raced wide of rivals throughout, never threatened. SUPER FLUKE was always outrun.
