NOW I KNOW broke to front along inside, rated well with clear lead into lane, responded to mild urging and remained well clear to wire. STORM'S PROMISE came four wide from middle of pack into stretch, no match for winner in drive but clearly best of others. YVETE SANGALO (MEX) was allowed to settle early, swung five wide into stretch, finished with a belated mid track rally. VALID A. J. vied for lead along rail into stretch, gave way. GRAND FOREST stalked leaders into stretch, had no rally. GENOVEVA (MEX) was never a factor. SOLID SCAM well back from outset, never a threat. MI LOCASTA forwardly positioned along inside for half, faded. EXPEDITIOUSLY was outrun. MINNESOTA THUNDER was never close.
