Footnotes

ALI TO WIN within striking distance along rail from outset, came off rail four wide into stretch, responded to strong handling during run to wire, got up in final strides. GRIS LIGHTNING was allowed to settle in stride for half, commenced bid racing five wide into stretch, responded to handling, finished well but just missed in a game effort. CHEROKEE GODDESS pressed pace outside of rivals into stretch, responded to gain narrow edge mid stretch, tired. BABY MAMA DRAMA raced in middle of pack along inside into lane, had no rally. TWO BUCKS A SONG well back at the half, swung five wide into stretch, improved position in lane. HERECOMEESWEET well back into stretch, failed to menace. DU GOOD BABY stalked leaders into stretch, gave way. MISS JAZZAROO was not a factor. TOO LONG forwardly positioned for half, faded. SOONER LUCK broke to front, set pace into stretch, stopped.
