BONANZA FLATS within striking distance along rail from start, moved up to gain advantage into stretch, drew off in late going. JENNY'S TOUCH vied along inside from outset, moved up to be nearest pace into stretch, no match for winner but much best of others. GOOD LUCK CHARM stalked leaders from outset, came four wide into stretch, had no rally. STAND WATIE came five wide from middle of pack, had no response when asked in lane. REBEL ROOY raced along inside, not a factor. PLEASANTLY SUNNY hustled to front, faded steadily after half. KENTUCKY BOOTS was never a threat. IMAWAYNETWO was always outrun. BALLADO MACHINE bolted into far turn, pulled up.
