CATCANGO well placed inside, advanced entering the turn but could not reach the winner. LOUISE'S FANTASY out run early, advanced outside entering the turn and finished well but too late. SHOWIN OFF dueled from the inside and tired in the drive. BOOGIE POWER was no factor. OSWEGO was no threat. TONIGHTS PROSPECT was no menace. EDITH ANN dueled from between foes and gave way. RUBYENNF dueled from the outside and gave way.
