SPECIAL TREE within striking distance outside rivals from start, three wide into stretch, gained nod mid stretch, kept to task and prevailed. CHARM AND A HALF was never far back, raced four wide of foes into lane, went gamely in drive but too late in a solid effort. RAN THE MAN dueled for lead outside rivals from start, came four wide into stretch, lacked the needed response in drive. ALL READY was never far back inside early, came three wide into stretch, moved up to loom danger mid stretch, flattened out. AMBERGRIS CAYE in back after a half, failed to menace. UNOME'S KANDIMAN was not a factor. BLACK IDA'S JO JO hustled to front, went gamely to mid stretch along rail, gave way. GRAEME PLACE was never a threat. KIAHUNA BEACH dueled for lead to half mile marker, dropped back.
