WHISKEY MAN dropped to rail soon after break, opened clear advantage before half, responded to strong handling in drive, prevailed. DREAMS D'ORO rallied from middle of pack four wide into stretch, responded to handling, finished well, gaining on winner late. GOOD TO GREAT stalked leaders from outset, came five wide into lane, lacked response when asked in drive. BLAZING BELLE raced evenly throughout. ECHO MIKE was not a factor. MATTS BROTHER ANDY steadied soon after start, chased leader into stretch, faded. PROUGH JOE was never close, eased after three quarters, crossed finish.
