SHAYEVILLE SLEW dueled along inside from outset, responded to take over at the half, kept to task during to wire and remained well clear to wire. NEWFOUND MISS allowed to settle in stride early, swung five wide into stretch, finished with a solid belated rally to gain second spot. CHANEL NUMBER MINE was never far back, came three wide into stretch, moved up to be nearest pace mid stretch, weakened during drive to wire. AFLEET WIND stalked leaders from start, moved up to engage pacesetter at the half, tired in drive. ONE CENT CINDY stalked leader from start, raced four wide into stretch, had no rally. BRESSIE was never a factor. FARRAH'S ANGEL hustled to front outside rivals, dueled for half, faded. SHE'S ON HER WAY was never a serious threat, racing on the outside.
