TURN UP THE LIGHTS stalked the early pace from the inside, advanced entering the second turn, altered outside for the drive, responded when asked and was along in time. IN THE BACKSEAT dueled from the outside for the early lead, remained engaged up the backstretch, battled through the second turn, held a forward position for the drive but could not keep pace. ETHICAL dueled from the inside for the early lead, battled up the backstretch, remained forward but could not match strides late. TIME IZ FLYIN forced the early pace from the inside but had nothing left for the drive. DA BELLDOZER was no real factor. EL BONGO was never close.
