TEETAU MARIE away in good order to duel for the early, gained a clear advantage entering the turn, widened the advantage through the stretch and was under steady urging late. ELISHA JOY far back early, advanced inside entering the turn, altered outside for the drive but could not reach the winner. BELVA CASEY stalked the early pace outside, made a bid entering the turn but could not keep pace. LIVESTOCK AUCTION up close inside, had nothing left for the drive. APPLE'S DELIGHT chased the pace outside but had no late response. CRAFTY G chased the pace from between foes and tired. MY LITTLE VAL went evenly. CARELESS LOVE was no factor. MILLESIME had a steady fade. SPICED was finished early. GROOVY HERO was always outrun.
