Footnotes

JEREMY TWO STEP dueled for lead from outset, responded to take over entering stretch, went unchallenged, ridden out to wire. OVERLY TRICKY was never far back along inside, finished with a belated rail rally to gain second spot. DEVILLE'S THRILL forwardly positioned outside rivals from outset, came four wide into lane, had no rally. CHACETHATWINNIE raced along inside, failed to menace. COZZENE'S COMET broke alertly to front, vied with leaders for half, gave way. YOU READY well back at the half, improved position in lane. FOXIE AN FUN forwardly positioned outside rivals for half, gave way. FLUSH AGAIN raced wide, never a factor. SCATAWAY LADY was never a threat. WHYNOTRED dueled for lead on the outside of rivals from start, gained narrow edge at the half, dropped back in drive. KELLIE'S JO JO pressed pace at the half, faded steadily thereafter. LUNAR MOONER was always outrun.
