EAGLE STORM dueled along rail from outset, responded to opened clear advantage into stretch, kept to task in drive, remained clear to wire. ROLL ON ROLL ON chased leader throughout, no match late for winner but gamely held unto second spot. I ALBERT stalked leaders from start, swung four wide into stretch, lacked bid in drive. NICK MISSED well back at the half, came five wide into stretch, failed to menace. WW CONQUISTADOR came from middle of pack seven wide into stretch, not a factor. ICE ROCKET never threatened. SIR PIKE showed little. DELIVERER hustled to front, vied for lead to half marker, faded. SO SENECA was outrun.
