SEEKING TREASURE dueled from the inside for the early lead, remained engaged up the backstretch, battled through the second turn with SHE'S MIGHTY FAST, put that one away entering the drive, gained a clear margin at the eighth pole and was clear late while kept to task. SATIN GOLD stalked the early pace from the inside, dropped back slightly up the backstretch, responded entering the second turn, altered outside and closed well late. DOT TO DOT unhurried early from the outside, made a bid entering the second turn but could only gain the show. PICO CHULO (MEX) chased the early pace from the inside, responded entering the drive and finished well but too late. SHE'S MIGHTY FAST dueled from the outside for the early lead, battled through the second turn then tired in the drive. SPOON FACE was no factor. CHENA MISS pressed the early pace inside and tired. NO SHRINKINGVIOLET had a steady fade. TWO STEPPIN' OKIE showed little. WICKED GOOD FUN forced the early pace from the outside, held a forward position entering the drive, pulled up, lost rider and was euthanized.
