TRULY TRULY TRULY dueled from the outside for the early lead, shook loose entering the turn, widen the effort at the eighth pole and was well clear while under steady urging. SILVER FLICKA outrun early, advanced inside entering the turn, responded entering the drive and closed well late. SMILES AHEAD chased the early pace from the inside, inched closer entering the turn, altered outside for the drive, responded but could only gain the show. CRUSIN' MAIN forced the early pace from the outside but had nothing left. SOUTHERN TIGER went evenly. DR T HUDSON was no factor. NINILCHIK was no threat. LINCOLN COUNTY dueled from the inside and gave way.
