EDGERIN J outrun early, advanced outside entering the second turn, responded when asked and was along in time. B'WANAGOLDMINE pressed the early pace from the inside, remained forward entering the second turn, responded to pressure but could not keep pace. LEE'S SOUTH dueled from the outside for the early lead, battled up the backstretch, remained engaged through the second turn, fought through the drive but could not match strides. POWER BALL SLEW forced the early pace from the outside, dropped back, responded entering the second turn but could only improve position. ELUSIVE PLEASURE went evenly. KENTUCKY MILE was no factor. PUCKSTER dueled from the inside and tired.
