KITTEN IN A PINCH rated off early pace, came five wide into stretch, responded to steady urging to take command and draw off in late going. CLASSIC CRIMSON well positioned outside rivals from outset, came three wide into stretch, responded to gain nod mid stretch, went gamely under pressure but unable to hold off rush of winner. CHILE FRITO allowed to settle along inside early, swung six wide into stretch, finished with a solid belated mid track rally. TALES OF THE WILD well back at the half, came off rail eight wide into stretch when making bid, flattened out. SHOOTITALL chased early pace, gave way before half. COMBATANT stalked pace on the outside of rival to stretch, faded. SERGEANT SAXTON hustled to front, set pace for half, dropped back. BUCKABOO was never a factor. TEXAS TREAT vied with early leaders, faded steadily after half.
