LEE'S SOUTH dueled on the outside of rivals from outset, went gamely to regain narrow edge mid stretch, proved best in an all out effort. EXPECT DOBBIN within striking distance from outset, came three wide into stretch, engaged leader during run to wire and just missed. HOLIDAY WEAWE was never far outside rivals, swung five wide into stretch, finished with a belated bid while racing mid track. HENRY SUNSHINE was never far back along inside, came three wide into stretch when making bid into stretch, flattened out. TRULY GONE WILD forwardly positioned along inside into stretch, moved up to loom danger mid stretch, tired. DICTUM failed to menace. OVER STATED dueled along rail from start, gained narrow edge at the half, gave way in drive. FARE CIELO stalked leaders on the outside to stretch, dropped back in drive.
