**Footnotes**

ARETHEREANYCOOKIES stalked the early pace from the inside, crept closer entering the turn, dueled through the drive and inched clear late. LUCKY DOOBEH chased the early pace from the outside, steadily advanced entering the turn, responded to pressure and closed well late. MAYDAY MAN chased the early pace from the outside, advanced entering the turn, responded but could only gain the show. ALWAYS A BLAZE far back early, advanced inside, responded entering the drive and finished well. SQUARE UP dueled from the inside and tired. BIG SKY OKIE went evenly. ITS A BIG TOWN dueled from between foes and tired. SILVER FANTASY forced the early pace and tired. PATS WARRIOR was no factor. HALF N OOPS dueled from the outside and tired. BREVET was no threat. EYE OF SYCLONE showed little.
