GENERAL LAKE rated off early pace along inside, swung four wide when making bid into stretch, responded to steady urging to take command and draw off in late going. CATTLE BARON sent to front, set pace to mid stretch, tired in drive, but much best of others. LASTING THE STORM stalked leaders along rail throughout, had no rally. ONE MORE LILLIAN was not a menace. BE A BIG STAR chased pace to stretch, gave way. J. C.'S RIVERCARD was always outrun. NOTABLE CYCLONE clipped rivals heels into first turn, eased into lane.
