Footnotes

COYOTE LEGEND chased pace from outset on the outside, responded to steady during stretch drive to gain advantage and draw clear in late going. LITTLE WAGON trailed after a half mile, commenced bid leaving far turn, came three wide into stretch, finished well with a solid mid track rally but too late. SMOKETHRUKEYHOLE broke to front, opened clear advantage into stretch, went gamely under pressure in drive, giving way grudgingly in late going. RED LEAD came middle of pack four wide into stretch, responded and close well while mid track but too late. STRATEGIC LEADER in back along rail for half, came off rail five wide into stretch, not a factor. J J'S INDY forwardly positioned for half, gave way. TIGER LAKE stalked leaders for three quarter, faded. GOING BALLISTIC was always outrun.
