Footnotes

SILVERBDANCING within striking distance from start, came four wide when making bid into stretch, gained narrow edge mid stretch, then was all out to prevailed in the end. NORTHERN CHOICE was allowed to settle in stride for half, came four wide into stretch, responded to strong handling in drive and just missed in a game effort. DIRECT FIRE stalked leaders from outset, came three wide into stretch, lacked needed rally in drive. FIVE ALARM chased pace to mid stretch, tired. RANGE RULES came from middle of pack six wide into stretch, finished with a mild mid track rally. TWO JAYS SECRET swung five wide from middle of pack into stretch, had no rally. YOUAREFUN failed to menace. ONE ROOM SCHOOL hopped at the break, not a factor. SUGAR STORM hustled to front, set pace for half, faded.
