### Footnotes

SHILAH stalked leaders on the outside from outset, came three wide into stretch, responded to steady handling, got up in time. SAINTLY SON rallied from middle of pack five wide into stretch, finished well with belated stretch run. SHOE SHOE SHOE well back for half, came off rail four wide into stretch, closed well with belated stretch run. RANDALL COUNTY vied while racing between rivals to stretch, weakened in late going. GAMBLING WOLFE well back for half, swung six wide into stretch, finished with a solid belated mid track rally. MR. DOUG STAR broke alertly to front, set pace to mid stretch, gave way. ABIT O IRISH chased pace for half, faded. BARRON DALTON stalked leaders while between foes for half, dropped back. JUMPER CABLES was never a factor. ASPEN MIST was always outrun.
