POSTTENSION allowed to settle in stride for half, commenced bid circled rivals leaving far turn, swung eight wide into stretch, responded to steady urging in drive, got up in time while mid track. LANG HEART well back at the half, moved around rivals leaving far turn, came five wide into stretch, responded to handling only to be outfinished in the end. RED SHOES dueled for lead form start, responded to gain narrow edge at the half, went gamely under pressure in drive, gave way grudgingly in final stages. BURNSY chased leader while on the outside of foes from start, moved up to challenge leader mid stretch, weakened in late going. WHAT A CHESTNUT trailed for three quarters, improved position along inside in lane. EARLYWINE failed to menace. CORNISH ROSE was not a factor. TEQUILA BOB hustled to early narrow lead, dueled for advantage along rail for three quarters, gave way. WANNABEAROCKSTAR forwardly positioned along inside for three quarters, faded. SILENT GLIDER was outrun.
