TA TA KNEEKNOCKER rated off early pace, commenced bid circling rivals leaving far turn, swung six wide into stretch, responded to strong handling in drive, got up in final strides. LEADING WEST stalked pace along rail from start, came off rail three wide into stretch, responded to gain slight nod mid stretch, went gamely to wire and just missed. DR. FLORA trailed early, moved up forwardly along inside leaving far turn, came four wide into lane to reach contention, lacked needed response in drive. TRIPLE X L broke to front, set pace along rail to mid stretch, tired. SHANE'S INDIAN well back early, improved position in lane. NOGGIN stalked pace to stretch, had no late response. BACKSTAGE KIRBY chased pace for half, faded. ROYAL ALAMO failed to menace. RED BEAU was not a factor. SMARTY WARD stalked leaders along rail for quarter mile, dropped back. DAT DOE DILBERT never threatened. STORM STORM STORM vied with early leaders while racing between foes, quit after quarter mile.
