GARBU'S TABACCO dueled from the inside for the early lead, gained a clear margin entering the turn, remained well clear at the eighth pole and proved much the best while under steady urging. SLEW SLEW WHO stalked the early pace from the outside, crept closer entering the turn, responded but could not reach the winner. LEAH'S HALO chased the early pace from the inside, advanced entering the turn, responded but could only gain the show. NICK IN TIME forced the early pace from the outside but could only improve position. SOMTHIN COUNTRY up close early from the inside but tired in the drive. YANKEE'S TREASURE was no factor. A BID FAREWELL was no threat. NASTY O'PLASTY had little interest. TALLEYBANK dueled from the outside early and tired. REMINGTONPARKSHARK was always outrun.
