TOO MANY SINS close up inside early, dueled through the turn, remained engaged through the drive and inched clear late. RICH ELM dueled from the outside early, battled through the turn, remained engaged with the winner through the drive but could not keep pace. MALABAR SLEW chased the early pace from the outside, advanced entering the turn, responded and closed well late. BULLCREEKROAD pressed the early pace from the outside, held a forward position for the drive but had nothing left. BELCHERVILLE dueled from the outside early, battled through the turn but tired in the drive. MISTER MINISTER was no factor. BET YOUR BOOTS was no threat. TWIN CITY SILVER had little impact. HENSHIN HERO had a steady fade. RICH ELM WAS DQ'D FROM 2ND TO UNPLACED FOR A MEDICATION VIOLATION.
