Footnotes

NOAH AND O stalked the early pace from the inside, inched closer entering the second turn, altered outside for the drive, responded with authority when stalked down for the drive and was well clear while in hand late. BIG JUMP unhurried early from the inside, advanced entering the second turn, responded but was no match for the winner while just gaining the place. MOUNTAIN GULCH outrun early, advanced outside entering the second turn, responded but was outfinished for the place. STROBE LIGHT well placed from the inside, held a forward position for the drive but could not keep pace. ALI BABA could only pass tired ones. RICH MONARCHOS chased the early pace outside and tired. ROYAL SCHILLING pressed the early pace and tired. BOOMER SOOEY broke sharp from the outside, gained a clear early margin, remained clear through the second turn then tired in the drive. JOE'S BULL was no factor. HUCKLEBERRY LARRY chased the early pace and tired. DUE TO GET EVEN pressed the early pace and gave way. RED WHO was finished after a half.
