### Footnotes

FRANZ dueled from the inside for the early lead, remained engaged through the turn, shook loose at the eighth pole and was well clear while kept to task. CHIFFOROBE chased the early pace from the outside, inched closer entering the turn, responded but could not reach the winner. ZENARO stalked the early pace from the inside, inched closer entering the turn, altered outside for the drive and closed well late. NEV'S LEGEND chased the early pace from the inside, made a bid entering the drive and finished well. BOOGALEE dueled from the outside early, battled through the turn but tired in the drive. S C CLOUD CAT well placed early from the inside, had no late response. GRAND AVENUE could only improve position. DAT RED CAT was no factor. KATILLAC CHARM was no threat. PROWESS had a steady fade. EVEN MATCH had little interest. SATURDAY'S SECRET chased the early pace outside and faded.
