FOREIGN SULTRESS broke sharp from the inside, gained a clear early margin, remained clear up the backstretch, continued to show the way entering the second turn, widen the margin at the eighth pole and was well clear while kept to task. SIS BOOM BAH chased the early pace from the inside, inched closer entering the second turn, responded entering the drive but was no match for the winner while clearly second best. CAPTATIVING STAR stalked the early pace from the outside, crept closer entering the second turn, responded but could only gain the show. DELLA MARIE pressed the early pace from the outside, remained forward for the drive but had nothing left. TALENT STAR chased the early pace from the outside but was no threat late. INDY FATIGABLE was no factor. WANDA OKIE was no threat. DANCE WITH HARGETT was never close. QUEEN KYLEE showed little.
