EYES OF A SAINT allowed to settle early, advanced inside up the backstretch, altered outside for the drive and outfinished rivals the final yards. LUVTHAT D'ORO stalked the early pace from between foes, inched closer entering the second turn, responded but was outfinished. BEFUDDLER well placed from the outside, advanced entering the second turn, responded and finished with good energy late. EVIL ATTITUDE duled from the inside early, remained engaged through the second turn, held a short advantage at the eighth pole but could not keep pace. NICKNOOK unhurried early, could only improve position. SHEZ A HALO raced evenly. CAME HOME LATE forced the early pace and tired. FASHIONABLEKARISSA was no factor. DU GOOD BABY forced the early pace inside but gave way in the drive. EXPECT FREEDOM was never close. TETON FIRE had a steady fade. COYOTE WAY ducked in soon after the start, hit the rail and was vanned off.
