BROADWAY EMPIRE broke sharp from between foes to gain a clear early margin, remained clear up the backstretch, held a clear margin through the second turn, widen the effort at the eighth pole and proved the best while kept to task. CAMEO APPEARANCE chased the early pace from the outside, crept closer entering the second turn, responded to pressure but was no match for the winner while second best. CARVE well placed from the inside, inched closer up the backstretch, held a forward position through the second turn, responded and finished well but too late. DEPARTING pressed the early pace from the outside, inched closer entering the second turn but came up empty in the drive. BRAVEMAN was no real factor. HOLIDAY MISCHIEF was no threat. TEXAS BLING was never close. HE HAS BLING forced the early pace outside and gave way.
