SCRAPPY ROO within striking distance along inside for half, commenced bid racing four wide into stretch, took over mid stretch, kept to mild urging while increasing margin to wire. MUST BE HE allowed to settle in stride early along inside, swung five wide into stretch, responded to handling but unable to reach winner and settle for second best. OCONEE stalked leaders on the outside from outset, moved up to challenged leader into stretch, tired. FOREST VOICES well back at the half, finished with a mild rail rally. WALLY'S CHOICE raced along inside, failed to menace. PASSPORT well back early, came four wide when making bid stretch, gave way. ACTIVE TREASURE hustled to front, set pace into stretch, faded. EARTHS VAIN SHADOW raced in middle of pack for half mile, lacked response. HESABIGCAT chased pace for half, dropped back.
