ROYAL AGO was allowed to settle in stride early, commenced bid splitting foes while four wide into stretch, responded to strong handling in drive, got up in time. SARATOGA YANKEE was never far back along inside, responded to handling in drive, just missed in a game effort. OKIETATE well positioned on the outside from start, came three wide when making bid into stretch, responded to gain nod mid stretch, went gamely to wire but couldn't last. PURE PANICK trailed for three quarter, finished with a belated mid track rally. SUNSET STROLL stalked leaders into stretch, lacked response. RITE TO RULE stalked leaders into stretch, faded. MAJHOOD chased leader to mid stretch, faded. MISS AFLEET ALEX was never a factor. ZONE AGAIN hustled to front, set pace for three quarters, dropped back.
