Footnotes

CHIVAZONE broke sharp from the outside, gained a clear early margin, remained clear up the backstretch, widen the effort entering the second turn, held a clear margin at the eighth pole then was all out to last. IT'S A SIGNER chased the early pace from the inside, remained forward entering the drive, responded but was outfinished. HOLLYCAL stalked the early pace from the inside, advanced entering the second turn, responded entering the drive but could not reach the winner. FIN DOCTORE well placed from the inside, advanced entering the second turn, responded and finished well. COUGAR'S ARROW could only improve position. STRETCHY was no factor. GRIND was no threat. SMILE FOR GIN was no menace. DEPUTY FOREST had a steady fade. MR. GOLD BAR was never close. MATCHLESS showed little.
