Non-winners of \$30,000 twice at one mile or over on the turf in 2012 allowed 2 lbs.; \$30,000 once at one mile or over on the turf in 2012 4 lbs.; \$30,000 at any distance in 2012, 6 lbs. (Maiden and Claiming Races not considered in weight allowances) Starters to be named through the entry box by usual time of entry. Trophy to the winning Owner. Closed Friday, September 21 with (43) nominations. (If management deems it necessary to take this race off the Turf, it will be run at a distance of 1 1/16 Mile on the main track.)

LOCKOUT up close early from the inside, inched closer entering the second turn, responded to duel through the drive, gained a short margin deep stretch then was all out to last. GOLDEN YANK unhurried early from the inside, steadily advanced up the backstretch, reached a striking position entering the second turn, responded when sat down for the drive but was outfinished. GLOBAL POWER dueled from the inside for the early lead, battled up the backstretch, remained engaged through the second turn, dueled through the drive but could not match strides. RANSOM ROBERTO outrun early, advanced outside entering the second turn, responded and finished well. DON DULCE dueled from the outside but tired in the drive. SKIP A SMILE was no factor. DAKOTA GYPSY chased the early pace but had nothing left. SOULTOWN forced the early pace outside and tired. BEACHCOMBING had little interest.
