LITTLE WAGON was allowed to settle in stride during first half, came off rail and circled leaving far turn, responded to steady handling in drive to game command and draw clear late. FLY THE RED EYE within striking distance while racing between rivals into stretch, moved up to loom danger mid stretch, no match late and settled for second best. SEEKING WEST chased pace into stretch, tired. REGIONS REWARD set pace into stretch, held gamely under pressure to mid stretch, gave way. WOULD YOU failed to menace. DUAL FORECAST was never a factor. ALERIC was always outrun.
