Footnotes

SONS OF SAMCRO rated off early pace while not far back, moved up smartly along rail into stretch, responded to handling, took over and drew off in late going. RAINY MOUNTAIN broke to front, set pace to mid stretch, tired in late going but well clear for the second spot. FIRE GAME stalked leaders from outset, moved up to be nearest pace mid stretch, flattened out. CAT FROM ROME within striking distance outside rival into stretch, had no rally. SILVER DANDY was never far back, raced four wide when making bid into stretch, faltered in drive. SLEWSAM well back leaving far turn, came five wide into lane, failed to menace. CHEEP SONGLASSES stalked leaders into stretch, faded. LONESOME GUY was never a threat. TUG HILL was always outrun.
